CORE VALUES/BELIEFS



We believe in the inalienable right to life and that human life is to be regarded as sacrosanct. It is a primary task of government to defend all human life and liberty.

We believe in the special responsibility of society to protect the vulnerable and powerless.

We believe in the freedom of conviction, expression and association for all people, provided that these freedoms are not at the expense of others. It is a primary task of government to maintain the proper balance between personal freedom and the common good.

We believe that the family (meaning mums and dads, children, siblings, grandparents and extended family, singles, single parent families and heterosexual couples that form a living community of people that interact and care for one another) is the fundamental unit of society. It is a primary function of government to respect, protect and assist the family and the institution of marriage upon which it depends.

We believe in the importance of the promotion of social justice, family values, environmental sustainability and economic well being and that political activity on these issues must take place with regard for the long-term consequences.

We believe in the value and dignity of work and resulting economic self-reliance and also the responsibility of all to share in the common benefit through just taxation. Taxation must not discourage personal or corporate endeavour and must reward economic activity that is innovative and beneficial and restrain activity that is injurious and destructive to society, the economy and the environment.

We believe in equal access for all Australian families to the benefits of our judiciary, economy, health, education and welfare services and also in the responsibility of all to contribute to these benefits through taxation and a culture of respect and hard work for the common good.

We believe that a free and democratic society depends upon the proper balance of powers in society and that no sector, whether economic, political, educational, judicial, media or religious should be allowed to control the means of production or communications.

We believe in the responsibility of all Australian states to act justly toward their citizens and responsibly toward the community of nations and the global environment.

We believe Australia has a role to maintain good global relations, especially in our own region, and to contribute to the securing of inalienable rights and equitable economic opportunity for those who are oppressed and deprived.
